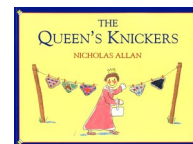

PARENT AFTERNOON - We look forward to welcoming the adults who will be joining us on Wednesday 20th for an afternoon of activities and fun!

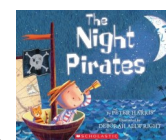


PSHE - Year 1 and Year 2
