ENGLISH and COME AND SEE - the children have been thinking about the different parts of the Easter story and have written about Palm Sunday.



MATHS - Year 1 children have been solving addition and subtraction word problems. They started by highlighting the key word in the question to decide what calculation to write

E.g. Sam has 9 pens. Tim gives him 4 **more**. How many does he have **altogether**? $9 + 4 =$

What is 18 **minus** 5? $18 - 5 =$

SCIENCE - in preparation for their trip to Weald park, the children have been learning about evergreen and deciduous trees.
