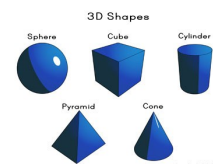


YEAR 2

ENGLISH - The children have had lots of fun using a variety of books by the Ahlbergs as a stimulus for their English this week. They enjoyed finding a different ending for The Jolly Postman story and wrote a postcard or a letter to a character from the book.

MATHS - Year 2 children need to know the properties of common 3d shapes, such as how many vertices (corners), faces and edges they have. Please use the 3d shape sheet that was sent home at Parent's Evening to challenge your children by describing a shape and asking them to guess which shape it is.



SCIENCE - For our topic of Keeping Healthy, Year 2 have thought about the importance of avoiding the spread of germs. They wrote about when they should wash their hands and that they should wash them for a duration of the 'Happy Birthday' song, to ensure they are cleaned thoroughly.

P.E. - The children are trying to improve their stamina by completing a daily 2 minute run. They could try to improve this by completing a 2 minute run on the weekends!

The Times Table Challenge next Thursday will be on the **10 times table**. For the 10 x table we learn from 0 x 10 up to 12 x 10 and 10 x 0 to 10 x 12.

This week's **Mathletics** homework is set up and ready to go. Have fun!

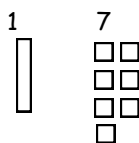
YEAR 1

ENGLISH - We have listened to some traditional tales, role played Goldilocks and the Three Bears and written a character description of Goldilocks.

COMMON EXCEPTION WORDS - Next week's words will be: school, push, pull, full, our

MATHS - This week we have partitioned 2 digit numbers into 10s and 1s.

We made numbers using dienes.



And so then worked out that 17 was made up of 1 ten and 7 ones.

We also wrote the number sentence to go with this $17 = 10 + 7$



SCIENCE - We have started to identify some native flowers. We can recognise snowdrops, daffodils, crocuses and primroses. If you spot any of these flowers when you are out and about please take a photo, bring it in to school and add it to our class display.
